Dan Linehan's poetry has appeared in the *Monterey Poetry Review*, *Porter Gulch Review*, *Pine Cone*, *Herald*, *Hazmet Review*, *Long Island Quarterly*, *Homestead Review*, *Anthology of Monterey Bay Poets*, *Oil Addiction: The World in Peril*, and elsewhere. He wrote the chapbook *Spindrift Through Ocean Archways: Poetry of Monterey* and has won awards for poetry, screenwriting, and nonfiction. Dan was the managing editor of *Ping-Pong*, the art and literary journal of the Henry Miller Library. His first nonfiction book was published this year, *SpaceShipOne: An Illustrated History*, which has a foreword by Sir Arthur C. Clarke. Barbara Mossberg hosts the weekly talk-radio show *The Poetry Slow Down*, KRXA 540AM (Sundays Noon-1 pm, www.krxa540.com) and has performed her poetry worldwide. Of all the roles Dr. Mossberg plays- scholar, lecturer, professor, leadership consultant, college president, academic administrator, actor-- poet is her core identity in a career of over three decades. She has taught creative writing, poetry, drama, and American literature at Indiana University (William Riley Parker Prize), University of Oregon (Ersted Distinguished Teaching Award), Bicentennial Professor of American Studies at the University of Helsinki (twice as a Senior Fulbright award, the second to launch the Senior Fulbright Distinguished Lectureship), twice winning the Rector's Medal of Merit at Universities of Helsinki and Tampere. She is founding dean at California State University Monterey Bay for the College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences and teaches adults about women poets and "literature that changed the world" for the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute.
